Whilst the applicant points out that the Mews is already a distinctive mix of architectural styles over the years (including contemporary), the integrity of the individual mews buildings is integral to maintaining the character of the buildings and the conservation area. These are not minor alterations. Replacing the original timber windows on this building with a cheap (and cheap looking) uPVC alternative detracts very visibly from the character of the area, and more importantly creates a concerning precedent for others that might follow (or the applicant himself on his other buildings) which would be wholly counter to maintaining the conservation area. There are many energy efficient options for double (and triple glazing) timber framed windows these days and these are what could and should have been employed here. Please ask for the timber frames on the windows to be reinstated as soon as possible. many thanks.
