At present a car wanting access to the mews can pull up to the gates without completely blocking the pavement. If the gates were to be moved forward cars wanting access would still pull up to the gates, so the pavement would be blocked completely (illegal). To avoid blocking the pavement a vehicle would stop on the highway (in the bus stop or on the opposite side of the street), the driver would get out to go and open the gates, return to the vehicle and drive in, all the while blocking the highway and preventing buses pulling in to the bus stop. The police correspondence is ill-thought out, does not address the problem of obstruction of pedestrians, traffic and buses, and if there is a minor problem of vagrancy it would only move it on to any of the other alleyways off Kentish Town Road. The photos submitted are all of the same vehicle and look like they are staged. The litter shown is minimal. This application needs to be reviewed by TfL/London Buses. We strongly object to this application.
