I have examined the Elderflower Tree in the rear garden at 15 Inglewood Road, NW6, located near the middle of the far side fence.

The tree in question is multi stemmed, 4-5 meters in height, has crown spread of 3 meters and the base of the tree measures some 35cm in diameter overall and individual stems are 15 cm in diameter.

The tree appears to be dead. Likeliest cause is its age.

It is our recommendation to have the tree removed with stump and another tree of similar value planted as a replacement

Key to terms in tree schedule

Species - common or local name.

Maturity - relative to species.

S = Sapling Y = Young, newly established. E-M = Early Mature, less than $l/3^{rd}$ life span. M = Mature, more than $1/3^{rd}$ life span but less than $2/3^{rd}$ life span. O-M = Over Mature, more than $2/3^{rd}$ life expectancy.

Retention Category - a relative measure of health and contribution to visual amenity. This is the evaluation

Green = trees whose retention is most desirable, high category.

Blue = trees whose retention is desirable, moderate category.

Brown = *trees which could be retained*, *low category*.
