Regarding the above application I object to planning consent being given for another restaurant in Neal's Yard.

When the current restaurant moved in, it was for a short time because of a temporary loophole in the law and it is not appropriate for this to be converted into a permanent restaurant premise on the grounds that restaurants cause far more noise nuisance for resident than retail premises and Neal's Yard is particularly sensitive to this.

In the last five years we have had many more food outlets arriving into Neal's Yard. When no. 16 was converted from retail to restaurant the acting officer assured me that this was the absolute limit allowable for restaurants in Neal's yard. Since we have had no. 3, no. 2B, no. 6 and no. 16a added as food outlets. More outdoor seating, more open frontages, more smells, more ventilation noise, more rubbish, more people smoking outside, more people hanging about around closing times, more noise in the evenings, more music, more shuffling of tables and chairs, less peace and quiet and undisturbed hours of sleep for residents.

We urgently need a more sustainable mix of use in Neal's Yard for the place to be liveable in. The trend has been towards a food courtyard and this is not in keeping with the character nor the residential aspect of Neal's Yard.

Noise is a particular issue in Neal's Yard because of it's architecture. The premise in question, no 3, is at the apex of the yard and therefor any sound from and around the premises travels and bounces of all the three sides of the triangle. A retail premise would be quieter and operate for shorter hours thereby causing less nuisance for residents.

I wrote to you earlier this month with more detailed comments. At that time I was still willing to consider a conditional change of use for the premises exclusive to the current operators of Native. I have since received more accurate information that a change of use is only relating to the premise and not the occupants which makes me now fully object to such a change of use for the same reasons as I did two years ago. It is still the accumulative impact of food businesses which make it increasingly difficult to live in Neal's yard. Because I have lived here for more than 20 years I have seen the mixed usage being compromised over the years and one more restaurant will stress the current situation even further.
