Re: Satisfying of conditions of approved planning application

The planning application above was granted with the fourth condition stating:

"Detailed drawings and samples of materials as appropriate, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant part of the work is begun: a) Details of all cladding materials and samples of those materials (to be submitted to the Local Planning Authority). The relevant part of the works shall be carried out in accordance with the details thus approved and all approved samples shall be retained on site during the course of the works."

Please be informed as follows:

- where cladding has been stated to be used on the plans, bricks with insulation behind will act as the cladding layer;
- reclaimed, London weathered yellow stock period bricks which will match the colour, shape and texture will be used, as shown on the photo below. As such, there will be little if any difference to the appearance of the property as the bricks used would be the same type.
- the bricks used will be pointed such that any new mortar joints blend in seamlessly with the existing elements of the building



Physical samples of the outer face bricks can be provided for inspection and approval with prior arrangement. Should there be any queries in relation to the above please contact me via email and or phone

Your approval of the the above is requested urgently, ideally by 30 January in order to allow critical impending structural repairs to take place.
