A Mansard roof would not match the terrace of Butterfly rooves.

Extensions have been built at the back of Nos. 12 and 14 Leighton Grove. Which have affected the original sunlight and light to No. 13 which is in the middle of these 2 houses. This has caused the need for using electric light most of the day to 2 of the back rooms most of the day.

Torriano Avenue houses and gardens back onto No 13's garden and the view contains odd Mansard rooves in Torriano Avenue from the back of the house which have spoilt the uniform design of the original Butterfly rooves. None of them are the same.

It would be so beneficial to keep the houses as near as possible to the original plans, instead of allowing a war to change something beautiful to a complete mess. Leighton Grove I think is one of the unique streets with a Crescent at the centre.

It should be protected as it has a peaceful set of tenants.
