On the cover of the Design and Access Statement prepared by Stagg Architects it clearly shows the new development windows facing Colville Place not only enlarged but now able to be OPENED! Huge windows altered to open onto the narrow settings of Colville Place and a few feet away from our existing gallery door would be totally unacceptable. Although the developers are claiming the preferred option for the ground floor space at Cyclone house is to have a gallery occupy it, this is a diversion as it could just as easily be a noisy office or retail space with huge windows opening and changing the nature of this unique street. It would make our listed gallery at no 1 unusable for business. From our experience of 17 years of occupancy the acoustics in such a narrow street amplifies conversation radios and day to day noises. Levels at which we cannot hold conversations on the telephones or serve our clients. Secondly: The height and scale of this development again dominates and changes the nature of what is a truly exceptional street and build at number 1. it would overshadow this listed building which should be properly protected by the Council. This oasis of a street attracts guided walking tours and admirers every day, and is a gem in Camden's Crown. Camden must protect its development and respect the views of the tenant's and voters.
