					Details of the restrictive covenant:	
					Pursuant to an Indenture of 2nd July 1925 (copy enclosed) my Freehold"s predecessors were expressly granted the benefit of the restrictive covenants which encumber the Garden House's title pursuant to a conveyance dated 15th January 1925 and made between (1) William Thomas Gittens and (2) Thomas Edward Milligan Grundy. In that regard we would refer you to the First Schedule of the Indenture:	
					"AND the Purchaser to the intent and so that the covenants hereinafter contained shall be binding on the land hereby conveyed into whosesoever hands the same may come doth hereby for himself and his assigns covenant with the Vendor and his assigns.	
					(1) Not to erect or suffer to be erected at any time any buildings or structure of any kind whatsoever whether the same shall be attached to the freehold or not upon the land hereby conveyed or any part thereof which would in any way interfere with the free and uninterrupted view as it now (or at any period of the year) exists over the said land and the pond known as the Hampstead Pond to the country beyond from the rear of the premises on the West side thereof known as Heatherlea Lakeview and Hillview.
