2018/0049/P	Meredith Whitten on behalf of the Covent Garden Community Association	Covent Garden Community Association 42 Earlham Street WC2H 9LA	01/02/2018 14:29:42	COMMNT	<p>The CGCA is concerned about the impact on this Grade II*-listed 17th-century terraced house and 19th-century outbuilding, which originally was a workshop.</p> <p>According to Historic England, 7 Denmark Street is Grade II*-listed in part because of the level of survival: "the building retains its historic floor-plan and much of its original exterior and interior character, with a hierarchy of original panelling, plasterwork and joinery."</p> <p>Further, the historic interest forms "part of an early domestic terrace, with a later workshop to the rear, the building demonstrates evolving patterns of occupation in this central London location."</p> <p>Any works permitted must be performed using methods and tools that ensure there is no harm to the building or the outbuilding's historic fabric. Given that the works involve a basement extension, the Council must be satisfied that an adequate archaeological survey has been conducted, as well.</p>
