Proposal:

Details of pole colours as required by condition 3 of planning permission ref: 2014/2464/P dated 17/02/2017 for the erection of pairs of poles with clear wire between the poles at 15 locations across the Borough comprising the Brondesbury 'ERUV'.

Informative(s):

1 Reason for granting permission:

The details submitted to discharge condition 3 of planning permission 2014/2464/P dated 17/02/2017 are considered to be sufficient. Although it was originally conceived that the colour of each pole would be tailored to suit the site specifics of each location, it is now proposed that all poles would be a uniform black (RAL 9005). The Council's Highways Department has confirmed that this would be preferable for production and maintenance reasons, as well as ensuring visual consistency with the borough-wide standard for street furniture such as this.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with the requirements of



policy CS14 of the Local Development Framework Core Strategy, policies DP24 and DP25 of the Local Development Framework Development Policies.

2 You are advised that all conditions relating to planning permission 2014/2464/P dated 17/02/2017 which need details to be submitted, have been approved.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
