On Behalf of Camden Nature Conservation Service we have assessed the above planning application against the biodiversity evidence base and have the following comments:

CONDITION 8: with regards to SUDS, the submitted documentation seems to be ecological sound, however further scrutiny by a hydrological expert should be sought before discharging this condition.

CONDITION 14: Based on recent submitted evidence then I believe this condition is no longer valid as stated and should be dropped.

CONDITION 15: Submitted documentation is sufficient to discharge both Conditions 15a and 15b.
