

## 24 Heath Drive, Hampstead London NW3: Materials and Specifications:

Hard Landscaping:

- 1 Entrance Gates: Low height 1.5 max (Sliding gates behind Yew Hedge)  
Painted Black.



- 2 Front Yew Hedge 1.8m H  
(With 1.5m high black chain link fence, set hidden within hedge)



- 3 Close Boarded Custom fencing (Painted Mid-grey) 1.8m H (Side and Rear Boundaries- Where visible. Where hedges are shown- Propose 1.8m high black chain-link fence hidden within hedge.



- 3 Trellis Screen to Bin and Bike Stores / and A/C units (Stained Mid-grey)





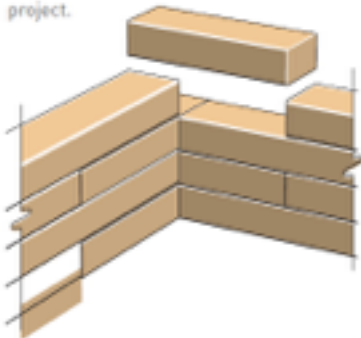
- 4 SIDE GATE: Edwardian Style: Painted Timber (Mid-Grey) No frame to RHS.



- 5 Retaining walls (Tiered planter beds)  
(Stained black)  
Horizontal Timber posts. (No foundations) Laid over existing levels.

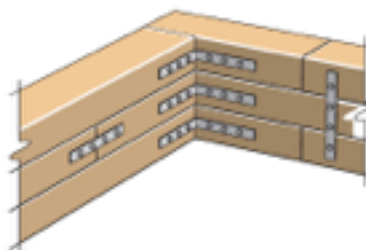
### Building

Build corners and walls using the coursing method as shown below. This will provide strength and stability to your project.

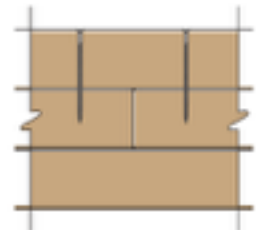


### Fastening

For walls, fasten the sleepers together with Grange Straight Landscape Connectors. At corners use Grange Angle Landscape Connectors.



Alternatively, fasten the sleepers together with good quality screws. Each screw should penetrate the lower sleeper to at least half its depth.



- 6 Low Screened Shed (Partly built into Bank) Maximum Height 2.5m  
(Stained black-hidden behind 2.5m H bay hedges.



- 7 Bay Hedge to boundaries as shown and to screen Shed.





- 8 Random Rectangular New York Stone Paving:  
Terraces and Entrance area, also Steps & 150mm Risers.



- 9 Resin Bound Gravel Driveway  
(Porous) , over porous asphalt.



- 10 Breedon Compacted Gravel pathways (Rear Garden pathways)  
Edged with Corten metal edging.



- 11 External Fireplace wall: With Slate or York stone walling. TBC.





12 Small Play-Treehouse (Freestanding (Adjacent to-but not attached to existing trees))



13 Box hedged Oval Lower lawn:





- 14 Wildlife Habitats:  
Bat boxes will be added to existing mature trees to the rear garden:



Log Piles (Re-using wood on site)



Native bulbs:  
Bluebells (To upper rear bank)



Snowdrops: (Under Grass areas)
