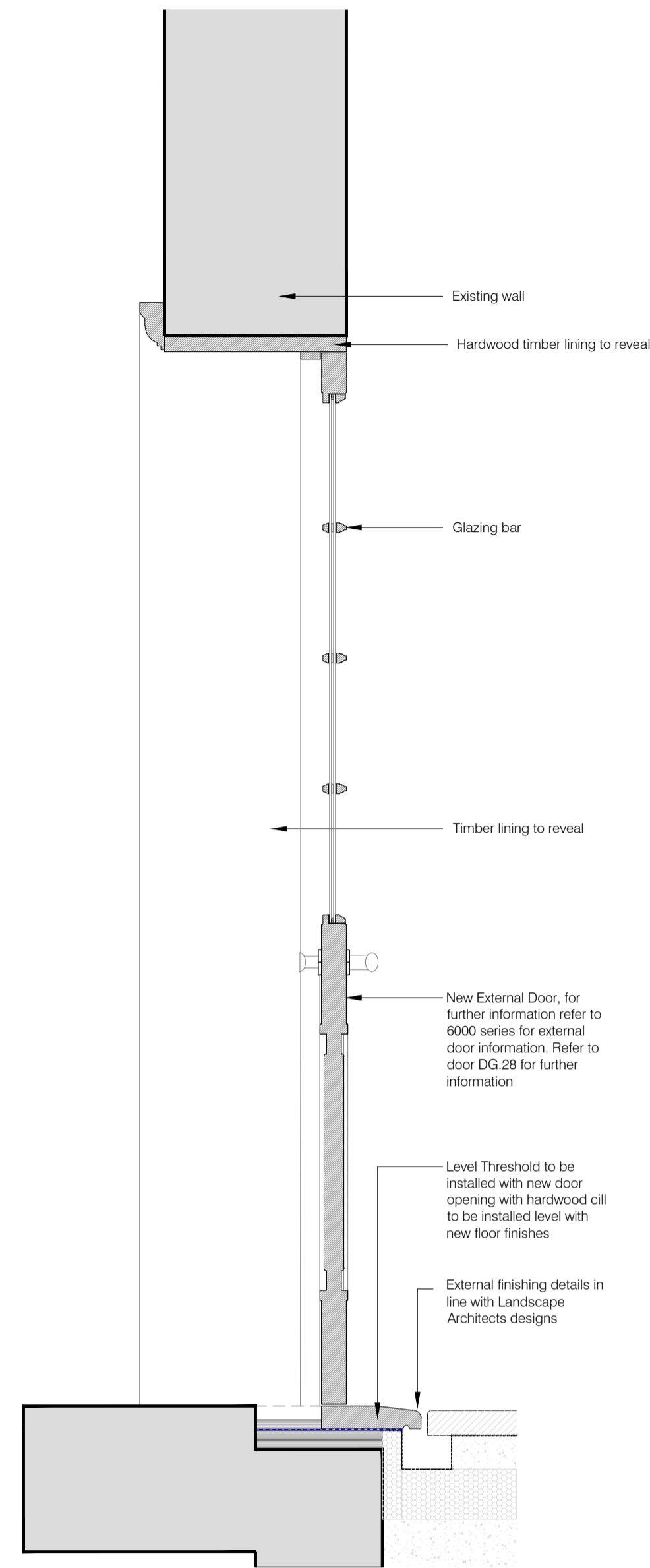


Where new opening is created, mortar to be inspected and made good to match existing

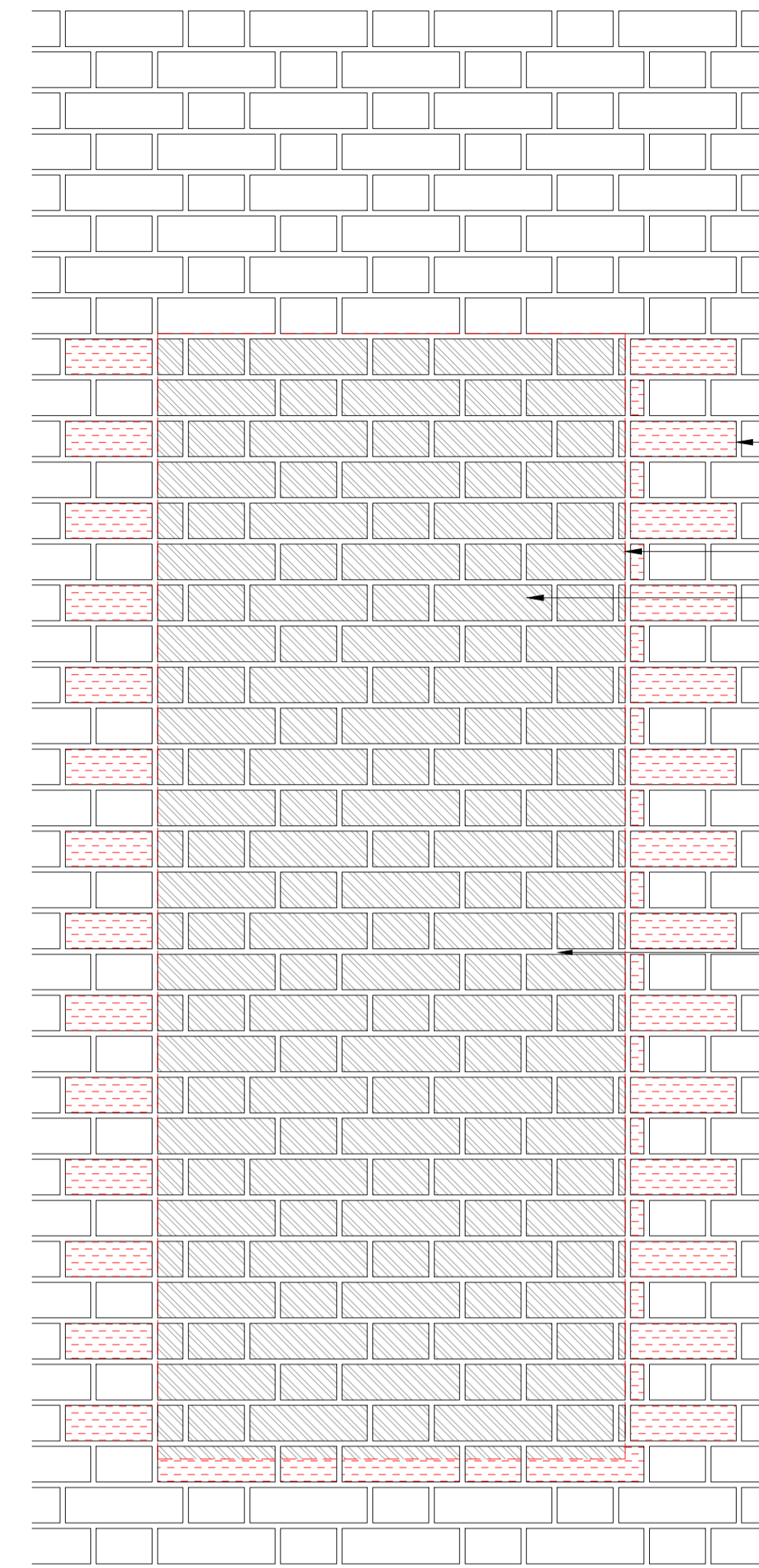

Section - New Door Opening Scale 1: 10



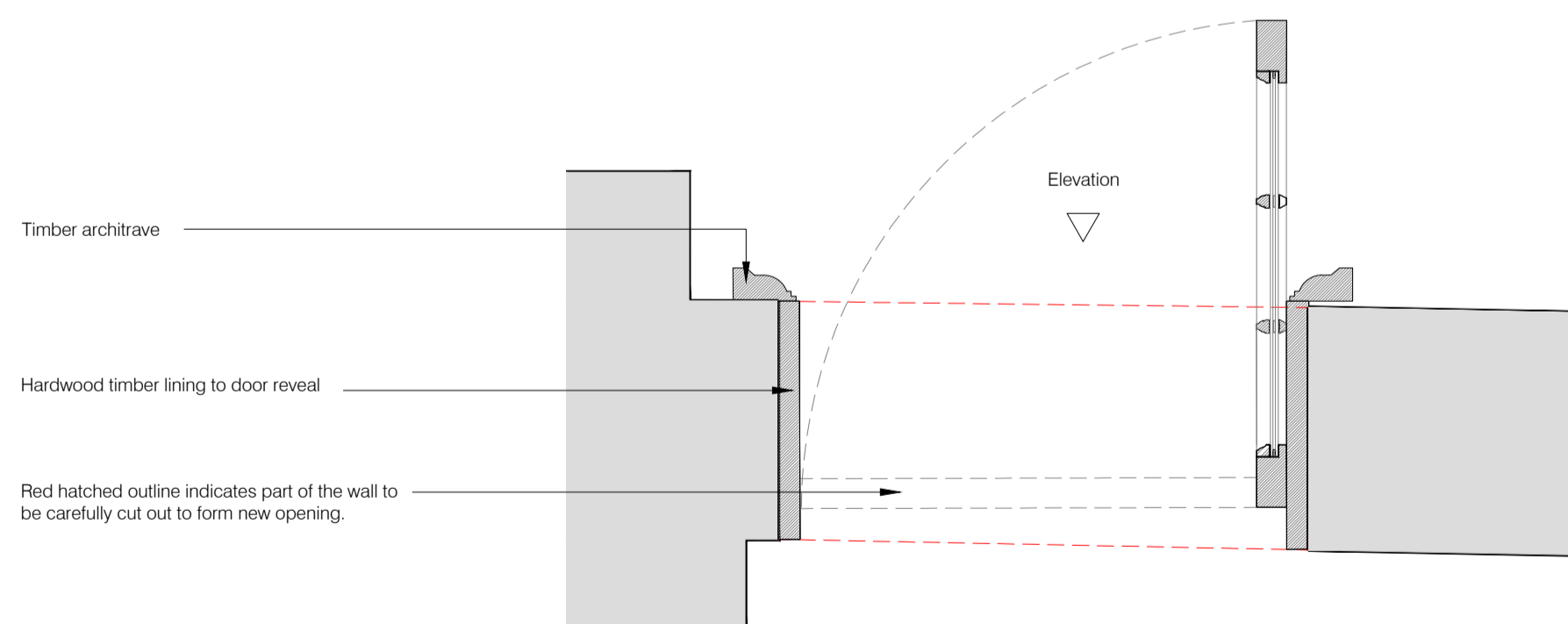
Red hatch indicates bricks beyond existing opening to be removed for upgrading works

New brick infill

Opening in brick wall to be fully bricked-up with matching brickwork; new brickwork to be aligned with existing brick wall; new brickwork infill as indicated by shaded bricks; all materials and finish to match existing. Where Bricks are indicated in red, this is existing wall that should be removed beyond opening to allow for full brick replacement. All mortar to be reviewed and made good where required to match existing. All restoration works to be carried out in accordance with Conservation Specification

Elevation - Typical infill wall detail

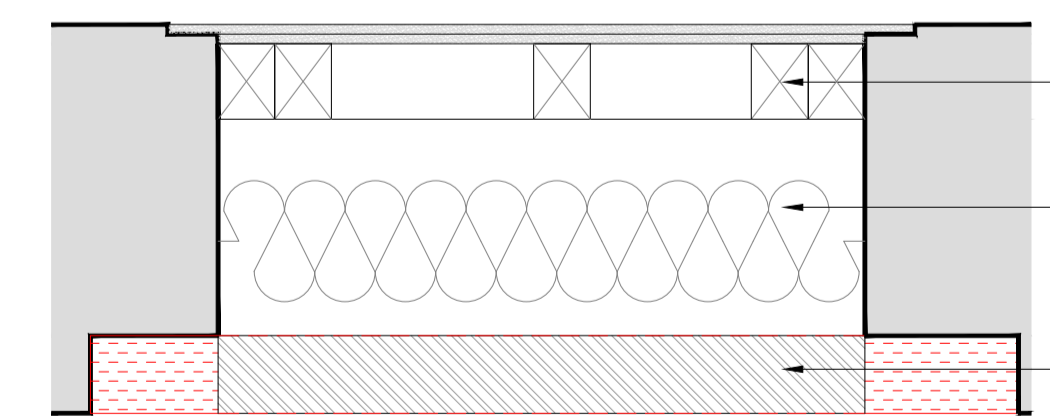


Timber architrave

Plan - New Door Opening Scale 1: 10

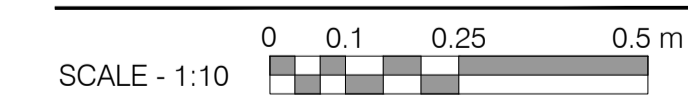


2Nos layers plasterboard finish on 100mm x 75mm timber framework tied to sides of opening
