I am writing on behalf of Kentish Town Road Action. KTRA objects to this planning application for the erection of a telephone kiosk outside 197 Kentish Town Road NW5 2JU.

The reason for our objection is that there is already a phone box in place, less than three feet away from the position of the proposed phone booth. It would be ridiculous to have two phone booths so close together, especially now that phone boxes are rarely used because most people have mobile phones. Another phone box will also increase the prevalence of street furniture, at a time when the street needs to be cleared of so many impediments.

We are asking you to refuse this application.

Should you recommend approval, we are asking for this application to be heard by the Development Committee.
