Currently the external staircase has 4000k round fittings installed. These are to remain in situ. Square/rectangle recessed fittings are being replaced as part of a maintenance exercise - with like for like 4000k. Temporary lighting has been installed by other, proposed works include removing these fittings as they are unsightly.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

All new fittings will be 4000k in order to fit in with what is already onsite. Lighting columns have been selected to be sympathetic to the industrial look of the building and offer much needed light for safety and security purposes. New columns to be installed at the sides of the courtyard to offer more lighting. Additional fittings to be installed on the upper walkway. Fittings are the same as the ones being replaced on the lower levels - giving consistency.
