

Mural featuring axed trees created to encourage a rethink of controversial £56bn rail route

Artist paints a grim picture of Hs2 'pollution'

HIGH Speed 2 protesters stood outside City Hall with a mural depicting the roads in Europe.

"The mural should help visualise the problem and show the destruction caused by Hs2 at the moment the tree felling is under way for the construction of the rail route."

Llywelyn Hall, who once painted a portrait of the Queen, came with an open letter calling for a rethink over development work around Euston station.

The authorities have already ignored a protest against the Hs2 route, which is causing devastation to our children's health. Safe levels of pollution and air quality are now in breach of Hs2. It is all without a defence."

Camden Council said yesterday (Wednesday) it would remove the "concrete-filled planters" outside Dudley Court sheltered housing block in Endell Street, Covent Garden. We contacted the council after barrister Tom Crisp, who works nearby, sent a photo into the paper saying he was "disgusted". Yesterday, he said: "The need to care for the increasing amount of homeless people in this city has never been greater, especially given the bitterly cold winter we are having. These anti-homeless

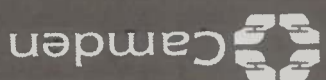
each of them around one-foot from ground level - warning "children: keep clear". The boulders are also in front of the historic Sir Marmaduke's Fountain that was donated by Sir Marmaduke Langdale in 1859. A "Langdale Marmaduke and Thomas distillers of Holborn" is mentioned in the Charles Dickens' *Barnaby Rudge*. The housing block was a former workhouse and now contains 23 retirement housing flats run by Camden Council overlooking the Oasis swimming pool. Its statement said: "These concrete-filled planters were placed on the public highway by a resident without our permission and we are now organising the removal of these, which should happen in the next couple of days." Schedule: Class A1 (shops) - A2 (financial and professional services) Development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class A1 (shops) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) to use falling within Class A2 (financial and professional services) of that Schedule and not being development within any other class.

Schedule: Class B1(c) (light industrial) - C3 (dwellinghouses) Development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class B1(c) (light industrial) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule and not being development within any other class.

Schedule: laundrette - Class C3 (dwellinghouses) Development consisting of a change of use of a building from laundrette to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) to use falling within Class A2 (financial and professional services) of that Schedule and not being development within any other class.

Schedule: Class C3 (dwellinghouses) Order 1987 and building operations reasonably necessary to convert the building to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule and not being development within any other class.
