Professional Indemnity Insurance and Limitations of Liability

We have cover for professional indemnity insurance currently in force under a special scheme that is administered on behalf of the Association for Consultancy & Engineering by Griffiths and Armour Professional Risks Limited.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this letter, our total liability under or in connection with this project whether in contract or in tort, in negligence, for breach of statutory duty or otherwise (other than in respect of personal injury or death) shall not exceed in aggregate the sum of £1M. Construction (Design & Management) Regulations

It is our legal duty under these regulations to draw your attention to this requirement. Please note that we do not expect to act as Principal Designer for this project.

For this commission the Association of Consultancy and Engineering (ACE) Conditions of Engagement set out in Agreement 2: Advisory, Investigatory and other Services, 2009 Edition will be incorporated within and will form part of our Fee Letter. In the event of any inconsistencies between this Letter and the ACE Conditions, the terms of this Letter shall prevail.

Payment
