Thank you for consulting Sport England on the above application.

## The Proposal and Assessment against Sport England's Objectives and the NPPF

The application proposes a floodlit Artificial Grass Pitch (AGP) on what appears to be a playground area.

### Strategic/Local Need for the Facility

Although it does not appear that the London Borough of Camden have up to-date and robust sport facility strategies for indoor or outdoor sport facilities and playing pitches, Sport England's Facilities Planning Model highlights a significant need for AGP's within the borough (albeit this focuses on full sized AGP's that can be subdivided for smaller sided football matches but there is still some need for football facilities). In addition the Football Foundation has no concerns with the proposal.

In relation to design, the proposed AGP has been designed in accordance with *The FA Guide to 3G Football Turf Pitch Design Principles and Layouts*. Sport England also understands that a management and maintenance plan, including a sink fund, would be drafted and that the facility would be available for community use outside school hours. This community use could be secured by a Community Use Agreement.

# Conclusion

Overal, Sport England offers its **support** for this this application as it is considered to meet its objective to provide facilities.
