I write to supplement my comment regarding the planning application 2018/0401/T. I submitted my initial comment to the planning department of Camden Council on 22/2/18.

I have looked in more detail at the plans. In addition to felling 6 healthy trees out of the application to fell 7 trees, there is a description to carry out works to many trees on the Elm Village estate.

May I remind you that all trees in Elm Village are protected by a Tree Preservation Order or TPO.

For works to trees covered by a TPO, you must provide written arboricultural advice and/or written technical evidence from an appropriate expert. For example:- a description of damage, vegetation, monitoring data, soil, roots and repair proposals.

The above must be provided in support of a planning application. Without such documents, you will be unable to approve an application to reduce trees covered by a TPO to 3.5 metres, for example. This proposal is entirely unacceptable.

I trust that the planned tree works detailed in application 2018/0401/T are unhesitatingly rejected. Thank you for your attention.
