1 Reason for Refusal -

The glazed privacy screen, by virtue of its size, location, material and detailed design, is considered to be an incongruous addition to the rear of the property and would have a detrimental impact on the character and appearance of the host building and the character and appearance of the wider Parkhill Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
