Proposal: Erection of single storey extension to south elevation; installation of external shutters and the formation of first floor roof terraces on north and east elevations; erection of portico and roof terrace to west elevation, and addition of solar panels; alterations to doors and windows; associated landscaping.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reasons:

Reasons for Refusal

The proposed extension to the south elevation with its associated landscaping, by virtue of its form, siting, scale and detailed design would be a dominant and inappropriate addition which would cause harm to the character and appearance of the host building and the conservation area contrary to Policies D1 and D1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.



The proposed alterations to the north, east and west elevations would detract from the character of the host building and would have a harmful effect on the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to Policies D1 and D1 of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and the National Planning Policy Framework 2012.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
