Dear Ben Farrant,

I am a resident at 85b Fitzjohn's Avenue and I am writing to object extremely strongly to the planning application for yet another house adjacent to ours. This is a conservation area. Houses have to be in line and not obstruct light and view. There has been enormous inconvenience from building works in the last years, particularly from 79 Fitzjohn's Avenue, which surprisingly seems to be much higher than surrounding buildings, and from the building of a house in the garden behind 83 Fitzjohn's Avenue. We cannot have another period of disturbance and the house proposed at 87 would be a monstrous intrusion on amenity and eyesore. I cannot see how it can possibly even be considered.

I note that the posting of the notice about this application post-dated the date for objection. I am sure this is an oversight, but I register the fact in case it is claimed that my objection is late.
