Proposal: Installation of replacement shopfront with associated non-illuminated projecting sign. Installation of two air conditioning units within acoustic enclosure, and installation of new flue to rear lower ground lightwell. Internal alterations at ground and lower ground floors.

listed building contrary to policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and paragraphs 126 to 141 of the NPPF 2012.
