The application is for a minor alteration to an existing entrance. The building is a block of 29 residential flats built in the 1960s at 95 Avenue Road NW8 6HY. The proposal is to remodel the entrance to allow for better safety, lighting and accessibility.

95 Avenue Road is neither a listed building nor part of a conservation area in the London Borough of Camden.

The proposed works include:

1. Retain existing entrance steps and handrail, and clad the steps and landing with new anti-slip tiles.
2. Retaining the existing canopy & removing a small portion to accommodate a new roof light. New structural beams are designed to sit on top of existing.
3. Aesthetic improvements to the existing canopy by adding a new metal fascia and a metal light shelf on top. The metal fin will be uplit by an LED strip in a niche underneath concealed from view.
4. Removing the existing entrance doors and fixed side windows at the entrance and replacing them with larger frameless glass doors and new glass windows for better natural surveillance and functionality. These doors and fixed windows are proposed to be aligning with the building instead of with the steps.
5. Removing the existing signage on the canopy and creating a new sign of cut metal letters on the low wall to the existing ramp with halo lighting. Please refer to Lighting Assessment attached, document ref 224-455-revision B.

There will be no effect on the existing access to the site or building.
