

I refer to the planning application for an extension at 29 Glenmore Road which I understand is due to be considered at the Members' Briefing tomorrow. The proposed raising of the party wall on the boundary with the neighbouring property by at least 1.5 metres will effect the natural light into the neighbouring house. Alex Bushell has conceded this, but no light study has been carried out. Prior to Camden Council considering this application an independent light study should be carried out by the applicant to determine more precisely what effect the applicants work will have on the neighbour.

The planning officer has also not considered the possibility of light pollution from the proposed extension which I understand will be largely glazed.

I would request that this planning application is deferred pending the carrying out of a proper light study to establish precisely what effect the extension would have on natural light levels in the neighbouring house.
