Informative(s):

Westminster is the Highway Authority for Great Portland Street but TfL is the traffic authority 1 for those parts, which are defined as "side streets".

As Great Portland Street is to be used to accommodate turning movements of HGVs, further clarification and/or additional information is required from the applicants in relation to the following:

- 1. Actual lorry numbers to be supplied to stakeholders prior to traffic liaison group meetings
- Given the predicted lorry numbers, conformation as to whether the impact on the highway network has been modelled.
- Pre-condition surveys to be carried out and route to be monitored for asset damage/deterioration. Consequential damage must be repaired by HS2.
- Details of risk mitigation to ensure the safety of pedestrians and cyclists around the Great Portland Street junction. .
- Confirmation as to whether signal timings will be altered to aid the flow of HGV and traffic
