I wish to object to this application for advertising consent on the grounds of public safety. (See also my objection to 2018/0880/P.)

The proposed new phone boxes are very near a junction that frequently has people jumping red lights. Sometimes this is clearly as they are trying to get through as the light changes but there have been other times when it has also been clear that the driver has not spotted the traffic lights.

To add extra visual clutter at this area by introducing advertising materials on the pavement will merely add to the chance of drivers being further distracted.

I therefore object to this application.

Dear Jeff Claxton

Thank you for your email.

The dates appear conflicting due to the type of application these are connected to. Advertisement Consent applications do not carry statutory consultations. The date showing as 21st February is the date the application was received. This automatically calculates the expiry date for consultation as 21st February. This is because when consultations need to be carried out, these give 21 days for comments to be forwarded to the Council. The Council is then permitted to determine any given application the day after the consultation expiry date.

In the case of Advertisement Consent, the determination date is the date after the application received date.

The registration date that is showing as being 28th February bears no relevance in the determination date of the application. However, despite the lack of requirement for/statutory consultations for Advertisement Consent, you are still permitted to make any comments should you wish to do so. You can simply email these to our Planning inbox at Planning@camden.gov.uk.

I hope this will clarify the rather confusing dates appearing on line in connection to the above application.
