You will see there is an arch, half is visible in my cellar and the other half appears to be in 50 Kentish Town Rd. You cannot demolish or disturb that arch in any way without something happening.
					Also can be seen in the photos, my wall which is a party wall with the coal storage next door (at 50). What would the effect be of filling 50's coal storage with no-fines concrete? With my Georgian wall on the other side? (mine is also a listed property).
					The work mentioned in the Design and Access statement obviously goes well beyond "Replacement of entrance steps". As already emailed, a party wall agreement must be in place.
