Details of qualified chartered engineer required by condition 5 of planning permission 2017/4684/P dated 06.03.2018 for: Excavation of the existing basement, including lightwells to the front and rear elevations, new raised platform at ground floor level, new landscaping arrangement to the front and rear elevation, alteration to flank fenestration at ground floor level and relocation of the western external staircase.

1 Reason for granting permission:

The proposal seeks to discharge condition 5 of planning permission 2017/4684/P, dated 21.02.2018. Condition 5 requires details of a suitably qualified chartered

engineer with membership of the appropriate professional body to be appointed to inspect, approve and monitor the critical elements of both permanent and temporary basement construction works throughout its duration.

The information submitted demonstrates that the engineers John Thomas Evans (CGeol) and Leo Luzzani (MEng, MSc) who have been appointed to oversee the temporary and permanent basement construction works at the site are members of the appropriate professional bodies and are suitably qualified to manage such works. The details outlined in an appointment letter accords with the requirements of the condition wording and policy criteria. Thus, considered sufficient to discharge the condition.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host buildings and streetscene, on the character of the conservation area or on neighbouring amenity.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policies D1, D2 and A5 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
