**Proposal:** Replacing 2x existing kiosk with the installation of freestanding BT panel providing phone and Wi-Fi facilities with internally illuminated digital advertisements

Many Thanks for consulting TfL, with regard to the above planning application, TfL has the following comments:

- The site of the proposed installation of a freestanding BT panel on Euston Road which forms part of the Transport for London Road Network (TLRN). TfL is the highway authority for the TLRN, and are therefore concerned that this proposal will affect the performance and safety of the TLRN and access to our bus services. The site is within the bus cage area and 24 hour per day, Monday to Saturday bus lane.
- The proposed telephone kiosk is at the front of the bus stop cage. This obscures passengers waiting for a bus and visibility of the kerb from the bus drivers. This is not acceptable to TfL as it impact on use of night services in particular and people with mobility impairments.
- Its limits our ability to extend the bus stop in the future and the ability for passengers to alight and board buses, if one or mores buses area already stopped at the stop. This is a busy bus corridor.
- Its also obscures road traffic signs on the footway

For the above reasons, TfL Spatial Planning objects to the application on behalf of TfL.
