



I am a resident at [REDACTED] and am concerned about the installation of an inlink WiFi spot on Euston Road. We already have a problem with antisocial behavior in the area and I am concerned that this will make it even worse as it will cause more people to loiter near the entrance of our flat.

For example:

1. There is always trash and alcohol left by groups loitering around outside our home.
2. My wife feels uncomfortable walking alone in the area as some of the men are drunk and often make lewd comments.
3. A friend of my wife was chased by a group of men who then tried to enter our apartment block behind her.
4. Everytime I stand at warren street station I get approached and asked for money, sometimes rather aggressively.
5. There are often large groups of 10-30 persons standing around outside our place or outside the bus stop gambling or talking loudly or fighting.

As Maz notes below, the phone boxes are bad enough and I have witnessed people using it as a toilet on more occasions than as a phone booth. However, a WiFi hub would, in my opinion, be even worse than a public phone booth. I would be interested to know how far the WiFi will extend and am concerned about it causing the area to become more unsafe. I also do not think that Euston Road is a suitable place for a WiFi hub.
