1 Reason for approval of details

The green roof would be a pre-cultivated UK native wildflower blanket made up of 24 species in a 100mm substrate. The submitted details satisfactorily demonstrate that the green roof is suitably designed and secures measures for on-going maintenance. The green roof will improve the biodiversity value of the site.

The details are therefore considered sufficient to satisfy the requirements of condition 4.
