The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reasons for Refusal

1 Reason for Refusal

The proposed front extension and replacement shopfront, by reason of its massing, scale, location and detail design would be an incongruous addition to the streetscape, eroding the character of the parade and host building and resulting in harm to the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policies D1, D2 and D3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan (2017)

2 Reason for Refusal



The proposed access ramp, by reason of its siting and design, result in a reduction to pedestrian ease of movement, clutter the streetscape and would be harmful to the quality of the pedestrian environment, contrary to policies D1, T1 and C6 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan (2017)

3 Reason for Refusal

The proposed front extension, by reason of its disruption to the otherwise consistent parade and obscuring effect in views towards other shopfronts within the Neighbourhood Centre, would be harmful to the character, function and success of the centre, contrary to policy TC2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan (2017).
