- 1.0 In preparation of repair works, support all existing supported at any one time works are to be carried out. Allow for two stones to be stone slabs with Acrow Props adjacent to where
- repair any defective brickwork support on other end Upon completion of Item 2.0 above. Examine and remove existing and defective timber lintels fixed to L shaped angle steel bracket 75 x 75 fixed with brickwork of external wall in basement. Replace with 100mm chemical bolts at 300 centres.
- Replace one broken slab with new reclaimed stone waterproof cement grout mortar. Clean all surfaces slab to match. Seal all joints between all slabs with
- Replace the dislodged and damaged stone to corner of site with stone pieces kept for repair Support stone pieces with steel plates carefully
- replace with new reclaimed stone slab to match. Remove the small concrete step to shop front and
- and replace slabs to existing positions. external perimeter step, make good brickwork below
