LISTED BUILDING ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ISSUED BY: THE LONDON BOROUGH OF CAMDEN

1. **THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE** which is issued by the Council being the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of Section 38 of the above Act because it appears to them that there has been a contravention of Section 8 of the Act, in respect of the building within a conservation area described below. The Council considers it necessary to issue this notice for the reasons set out in paragraph 4 below.

2. THE LISTED BUILDING

Land at: 38 Lamb's Conduit Street, London, WC1N 3LJ as shown outlined in black on the attached plan ("the Property").

3. THE CONTRAVENTION ALLEGED

Without listed building consent: Installation of two air conditioning units within acoustic enclosure, and installation of new flue to rear lower ground lightwell.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

- a) The work outlined above has been carried out to this Grade [II] listed building without the benefit of Listed Building Consent.
- b) The proposed plant including the equipment, enclosure and external flues, by virtue of their position on the building and their scale, form, and detailed design would harm the special architectural and historic interest of the listed building contrary to policy D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Within a period of three month of the Notice taking effect:

Remove the unauthorised air conditioning units, associated enclosure and extract flue, make good any damage and restore the lightwell to its previous state.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 5th June 2018 unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.

Failure to comply with a listed building enforcement notice, which has taken effect, can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.
