Further to the receipt of the BIA with no objections, we would like to respond to the Primrose Hill Advisory Committee's comments. Please therefore find attached a revised design to the front light-well, replacing the previous railings with a grille at ground level. This will provide an uninterrupted elevation in keeping with the original shop front.

As requested we have also developed an outline landscape design to define the private front garden area without obstructing the visual appreciation of shop front. The design incorporates low–level planting and the requested York stone paving, with gravel areas providing access to the shop window.
