					The proposed new facades front and rear would be highly visible at least most of the year, contrary to the claim in the application (which masks the visibility without justification by arguing that this would be hidden by trees- that would not be true most of the year when trees are not in full leaf.	
					The proposed mirrored glass of the proposed new front elevation will surely cause residents opposite (such as ourselves at no 13 Elsworthy Road) to suffer adversely from the reflection and also extensive light pollution at night time.
