- T14 - Acer pseudoplatanus - 1-2 metres reduction,
- T15 - Betula Pendula - Clear building by 2m
- T16 - Acer pseudoplatanus - Crown reduce by 1-2 metres
- T17 - acer campestre - Clear building by 2m
- T18 - Fraxinus Excelsior - Deadwood and reduce by 1-2 metres
- T19 - Robinia pseudoacacia - Clear lamp column by 1m and crown raise to 4m
- T20 - carpinus betulus - Clear building by 1m and crown raise to 3.5m
- T21 - Acer pseudoplatanus - Clear building by 1 metre, crown raise to 3.5 and crown clean
- T22 - Acer pseudoplatanus - Clear building by 1 metre, crown raise to 3.5 and crown clean
- T23 - Sumach - Reduce the height of the tree, poison at 2.5 metres to maintain the support of the Ivy
- T24 - Acer Platanoides - Clearing building by 1.5 metres, prune minor limbs away from the lamp column and crown raising to 3.5 metres
- T25 - Paulownia - Reduce by 1-2 metres
- G1 - Carpinus Betulas x 2 - Crown raise to 3.5m 2 hornbeam opp T6
- G2 - acer campestre x 4 - Crown raise to 4m and crown clean, clear building by 1 metre
- G3 - Sorbus aria - Crown raise all 8 trees to 3.5m and clear building by 1m
- G4 - Acer Campestre x 2 - Clear buildings by 1 metre
- H1 - Pyracantha - Reduce to height of fence and trim sides

All tree work is proposed as general maintenance.
