E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

Rear Garden:

Sycamore: Approximately 23.00m. Thin crown density throughout by 20%. It is essential that branch ends are thinned to ensure balanced and healthy crown structure. Judiciously raise crown by approximately 1.50-2.00m and remove dead wood. Reduce one extraneous branch growing over property to the rear by approximately 1.00-1.50m back into main crown structure. Reasons - increase light levels, help abate nuisance, help reduce potential hazards, help reduce leaf area without causing thick-fast regrowth and help to curtail the tree's sphere of influence whilst preserving the tree's natural characteristics and aesthetic value.

Eucalyptus: This young tree is growing close to the left of the sycamore and is now getting rather tall. It has the potential to exceed the height of the sycamore tree within 10 to 12 years. Reduce main branch leader by approximately 40% back into main crown structure and reduce remaining crown by approximately 20-25% to balance and regular maintenance.
