I am writing to raise my concerns at the proposal to fell a tree in the front garden of the above property.

As you are aware this mature tree is in the front garden of a conservation area that has already lost a significant number of mature trees. In my view its removal will have a further significant impact on the character and landscape of this local environment and its enjoyment by residents and other members of the public who use this street.

I do realise that this tree is on private property and there may be concerns about it that I am unaware of. However I wonder if other options could be considered. For example if there are any concerns about the size of the tree then perhaps crowing is an option? Perhaps it would be possible for you to visit the site?

My overall concern is that so many trees have been felled in this street recently and I do hope the council as a minimum will require the applicant for these intended works to restock at the same site with a similar tree of their choosing.
