Thank you for your letter of 4 May 2018 notifying Historic England of the application for listed building consent relating to the above site.

At the point of consultation we were unable to find an Application Form, Block Plan or Heritage Assessment on your website. In order to understand the impact of these proposals we should be provided with a Heritage Assessment that explains whether or not the features to be removed, such as the York stone flooring and bookshelves, are of significance. There are two separately listed buildings within the area shown on the location plan provided and it would be helpful if a block plan could indicate which heritage asset is affected. In addition it would be useful to see a mock up or example images of the proposed new fittings where these are available.

In our view the information that you have sent with the notification letter is insufficient for us to assess the effect of the proposal on the significance of the application site. We therefore recommend that you should seek further information from the applicant.

Please let me have the necessary additional information in time for us to comment again before the application is determined. It would therefore be helpful if you could let me know the deadline for receiving our advice once the additional information has been provided.
