I wish to complain most strongly against the proposed plans for demolition and reconstruction at 100 Avenue Road. The amount of disruption and distress that will be caused around Swiss College and particularly Brookside Road with its Myra Barnett special housing and other residences is totally unacceptable. From all reports of meetings between Camber and EL it would appear to the simplest of minds that the Council have given in to every demand made on them with the absolute minimum of consultation with the residents of this area. There is even an admission of possible collusion between EL and Council members. A great deal more consultation is needed on this project to protect the residents of the whole Swiss College area from the disruption of their peace and quiet, by ensuring all the builder's traffic is processed into the A41 and banning all movement at night.
