Engineering opinion is that damage is due to clay shrinkage subsidence. Foundations are bearing on to clay.					
3. The clay subs	3. The clay subsoil has a high volume change potential (NHBC Guidelines) and will shrink and swell with changes in soil moisture.				
4. Oedometer strain values indicate severe desiccation in BH1 between 2.0 – 3.0m bgl.					

7. Identification Of Tree(s) And Description Of Works 5. Live lime roots were recovered from below foundation depth in TP/BH1 (Feb 2017) to a depth of 4.0m below ground level. 6. Level monitoring for the period 08/05/2017 to 19/03/2018 has recorded a cyclical pattern of movement indicative of the effects of the lime trees on soil moisture and volumes to the front of the property. The uplift phase of the building can only be attributable to an expanding clay soil from a desiccated state due to the soil drying effects of the trees. 7. Drains can be discounted as a causal factor given the soil descriptions and by reference to the level monitoring data. 8. No tree works have been carried during the period of the monitoring. Established evidential and legal tests pertinent to subsidence damage claims have been met and the evidence confirms that on the balance of probabilities there can be no other cause of the movement and associated damage other than the indirect influence of the subject lime trees. Given their proximity to the front of the property, removal offers the only predictable arboricultural solution in abating their influence. 8.
