Dear Nora-Andreea Constantinescu,

Thanks for consulting TfL on this development proposal. TfL has the following comments.


- It is unclear from the submitted drawings how far exactly the proposed kiosk would be sited from the station entrance, as the distance is not shown on the Site Location plan.
- The orientation of the kiosk in relation to Euston Road A501, which is part of the Transport for London Road Network (TLRN), is also unclear. TfL is the highway authority for the TLRN, and is therefore concerned about any proposal which may affect the performance and/or safety of the TLRN.
- TfL reminds the applicant and Council that the London Plan favours decluttering and simplifying the streetscape wherever possible (see policy 6.10) and this is also prioritised in TfL Streetscape Guidance (available from <https://tfl.gov.uk/corporate/publications-and-reports/streets-toolkit>)
- In conclusion, TfL requests further information on the orientation and exact positioning of the kiosk, especially which direction the advertisements on it would face, how much it would narrow the footway, and where it would stand in the footway in relation to the adjacent street furniture, infrastructure and building accesses
- Installation of the kiosk and advertisement may cause unacceptable highway safety issues on Euston Road A501 due to increased potential for driver distraction.
- **Please provide further detail for TfL to make a better judgement on this matter.**
