Thanks Tony. I've spoken with our supplier and have updated below accordingly and will send updated drawings and TPO doc shortly.

In addition to the challenges I've outlined over the risk of greenery spreading to the interior of the building because of the overlapping roof structure, I wanted to add another point. The roof of our structure is sloping with the highest point at 2.5m at the front, sloping down to 2.165m at the back. This is already quite a low roof for Zack, who is 1.91metres tall. A sedum roof would need to slope further to drain water which would make it difficult for Zack to comfortable use the structure, and even more so because we want to use the space to exercise in. Hope this is ok. We are happy to plan more plants in our garden or compensate in another way.
