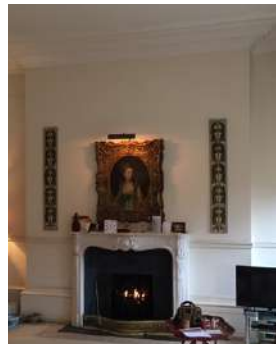

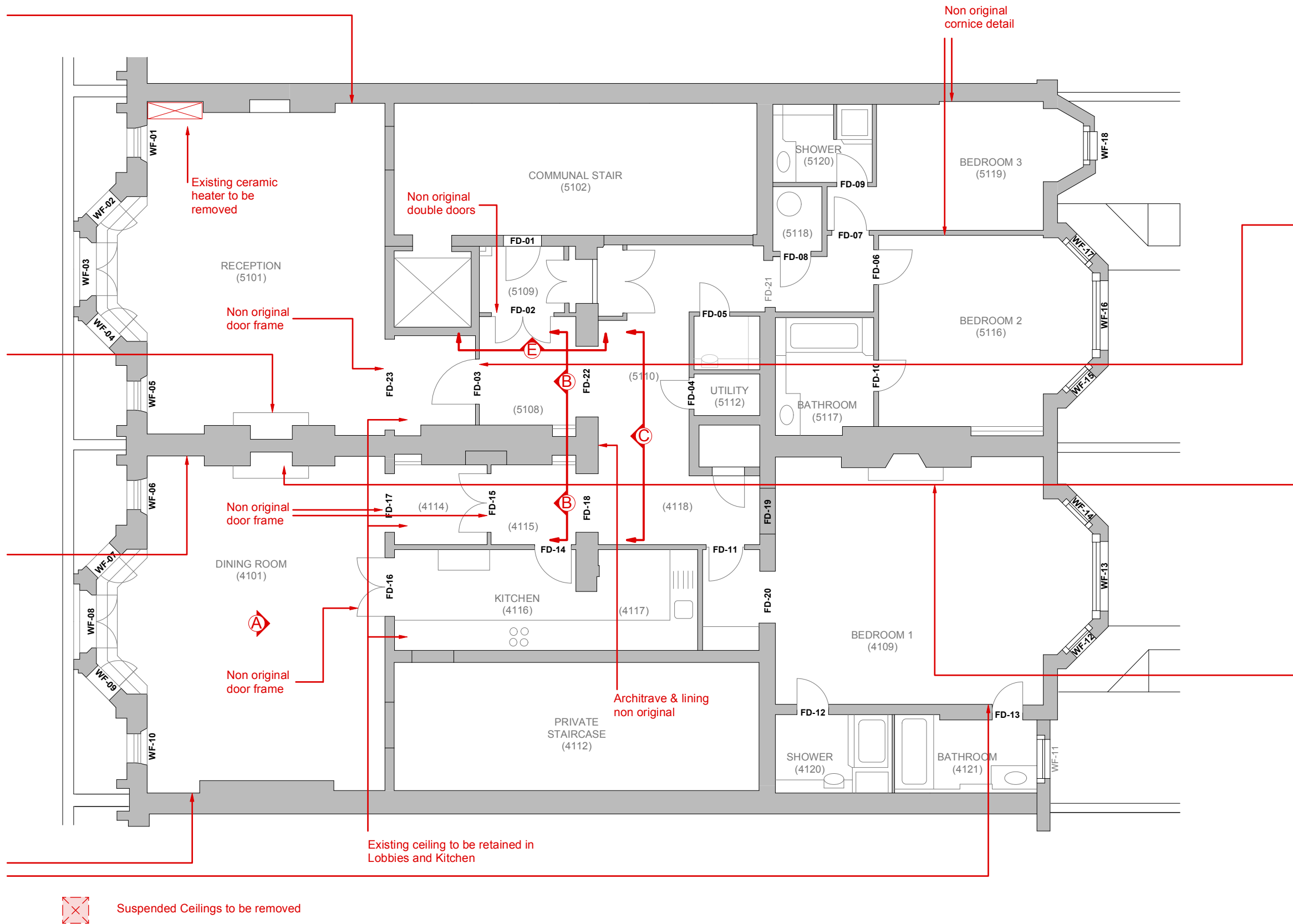

Original door FD03 - six panels with margins



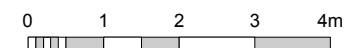
