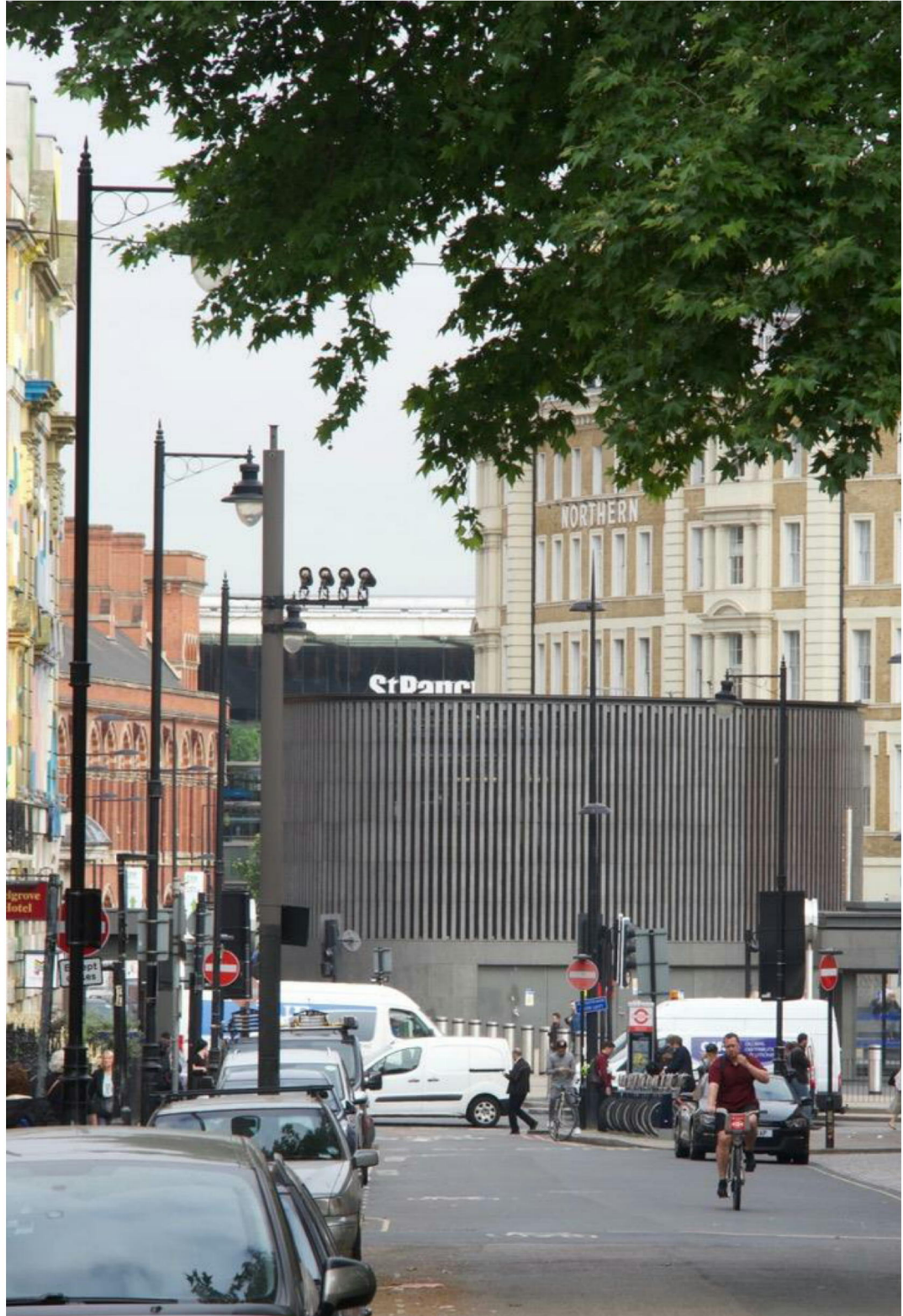

Dear Charles,

Please could I object to the application for the display of two internally illuminated digital media screens (4m high x 27m wide and 6.5m high x 60m wide) on the ventilation shafts at Kings Cross Square on behalf of the Friends of Argyle Square?

This shaft structure closes a vista from one side of Argyle Square down Belgrove Street, and covering it in a back illuminated advertising hoarding will have a significant detrimental effect on half of the Square. In fact this proposal is so unacceptable that we are surprised it even reached the point of the application being made, as it would also seriously detract from the setting of two prominent Grade 1 Listed buildings adjacent to a public square.
