Statement of Community Engagement for Mosaic School Cafeteria

London School of Mosaic aims to bring back into use 7 garages next to their entrance under Ludham Mansions for the benefit of the wider community.

We already have residents of Ludham Mansions and local residents as trustees, on our governing body, as well as working for us. We have incubated a social enterprise called Ludham Undercroft Community Interest Company (LUCIC) which defines members as all those who live on Ludham and Waxham housing estate.

Every week during term time we run a free residents' mosaic making session and resident/members who live on our estate attend this. We share artisan skills and residents let us know how we could best support them. For members to be active they initially attend these free sessions and then can take up voluntary or paid posts with us.

In addition we run free weekly sessions for Camden Youth Offending team, taking some of the most troubled young people in the borough, working with local volunteers to improve their skills and life chances.

The Mosaic School Cafeteria will aim to provide catering facilities for our students which in October 2018 we estimate to be in the region of 40-50 people per week. We aim to employ local people, run a senior citizens club from the cafeteria and be a community asset. We are a non-profit making charity whose aim is to make our neighbourhood more attractive and safe.
