Dear Mr McClue


I feel concerned about the issue raised by Janine Sachs in the *Camden New Journal* of 7 June (I don't know Ms Sachs).

As she suggests, the mound opposite Swiss Cottage Library would be a better position for The Hampstead Figure than behind the sports centre. The sculpture is of historic importance as an integral part of the Civic Centre site (1964) and should be seen more clearly. It would probably be less visible on the Adelaide Road side.

As a Camden Tour Guide,* I followed the Mayor's Charity Walk in 2016, with Cllr Naz Shah, which included the sculpture in relation to the Civic Centre. I believe it deserves to be featured on the same basis in future Swiss Cottage walks.
