# Proposal:

TPO REF (C649) VARIOUS WORKS TO VARIOUS TREES, including::

1 x Fraxinus Excelsior T8 - Fell and grind strump and replant

1 x Fraxinus Excelsior T9 - Fell and grind stump and replant

The Council has considered your application dated 14 May 2018 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

## Conditions and Reasons:

This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.



- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)
  - Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).
- During the first available planting season following the completion of works, 2 trees of a species and size to be agreed with the council shall be planted unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local authority. The trees shall be planted and maintained to the standards set out in BS8545:2014 and shall be planted in the pits that application trees T8 and T9 are currently occupying.

Reason: In order to ensure the biodiversity of the site is conserved in accordance with the requirements of policy A3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan June 2017.

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
